INTRODUCTION

- Our Herd Health programme is all about helping herdowners achieve the best possible performance from their herds through maximising health and management.
- The Munster Bovine Herd Health programme has been running since 2013 with almost 3,000 herd owners set to avail of the service in 2023.
- The greatest testament to the Herd Health programme is that once farmers join, they continue to use the service year on year.

WHAT IS TESTED AND HOW IS TESTING COMPLETED?

- All you have to do is sign up and we organise everything else. Milk samples are collected from your bulk tank at 4 strategic times during the year. A variety of tests are carried out depending on the month of collection.
- The table below illustrates what diseases are tested for and when the various tests are carried out.
- After each round of testing, the results are posted to each herd owner and emailed to their own vet if requested.

WHAT IS ACHIEVED AT THE END OF YEAR VET MEETING?

The end of year consultation is a full review of your herds performance. Expert advice is provided on each of the following areas.

- Production and Breeding Your herd's genetic potential and performance is established. Is performance meeting the genetic potential of the herd?
- Disease and vaccination Disease results are analysed, and the herds vaccination plan is reviewed. Each herdowner receives a vaccination plan for their herd.
- Parasites and dosing Dosing history is reviewed, and plans are put in place for the Winter and the following grazing season.
- SCC and mastitis Milk recording results are analysed and reviewed. Is your herd suitable for selective dry cow therapy?
- Nutrition Your herds milk recording data is analysed for evidence of negative energy balance and acidosis during lactation.
- Johnes disease If your herd is testing for Johnes through milk recording, your results will be available for analysis.
